EXECUTIVE SUMMARY





Suriname's Ministry of Natural Resources has embarked on a groundbreaking program, utilizing its enormous high quality fresh water resources to combat global and regional physical and economic water scarcity.

In 2012, the Suriname government granted Amazon Resources AG, a Swiss Company, a 40-year concession on the surface water of all the rivers of the country by Presidential Decree. This Presidential Decree was recently renewed on February 20, 2018. Amazon Resources AG, is a dedicated legal entity and has the rights and responsibility for the implementation of the program. The Presidential Decree allows to harvest 6-12% of the annual outflow of 151 Billion m3 per year.

The location of environmental friendly harvest of non-polluted water, is circa 100 km to the east of Paramaribo close to Raleigh Vallen Nature Reserve. The non-polluted water is safe according to WHO standards, a Waterquality report is available.

The gold, oil and other metal sources winning activities are in a different area, to the west and south of Paramaribo. No cross pollution can take place.

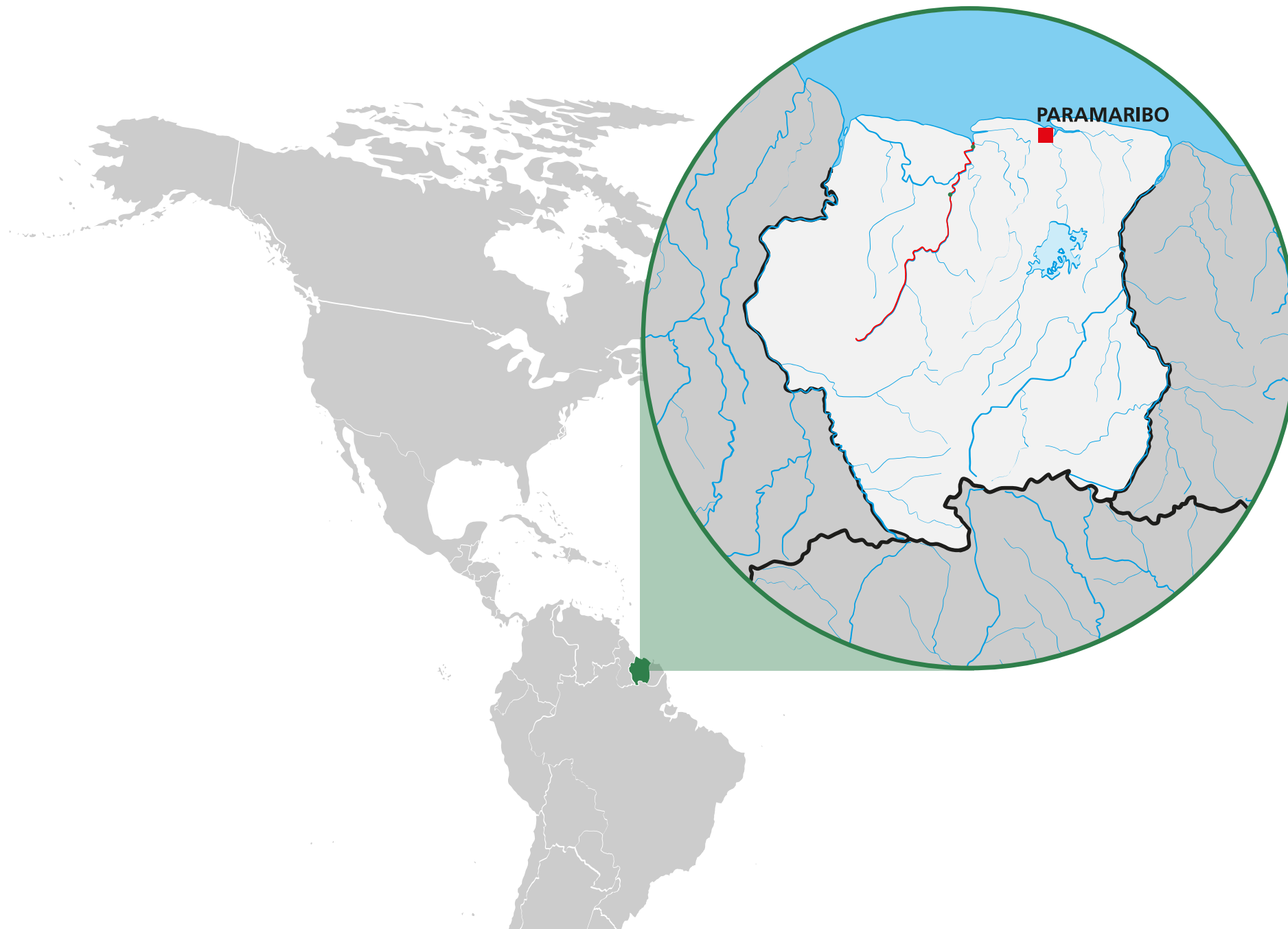
Various options of business are described. These options can be executed in parallel since taken together it will never exhaust the abundant renewable resources of water available, since the Presidential Decree allows to harvest **6-12%** of the annual outflow of **151 Billion m³** per year, this translates into **9 Billion m³ – 18 Billion m³** per year.

Because of the immediate water shortages around the globe, the business cases on the basis of other options will always turn out much more profitable than calculated in the options.

The option is:

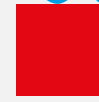

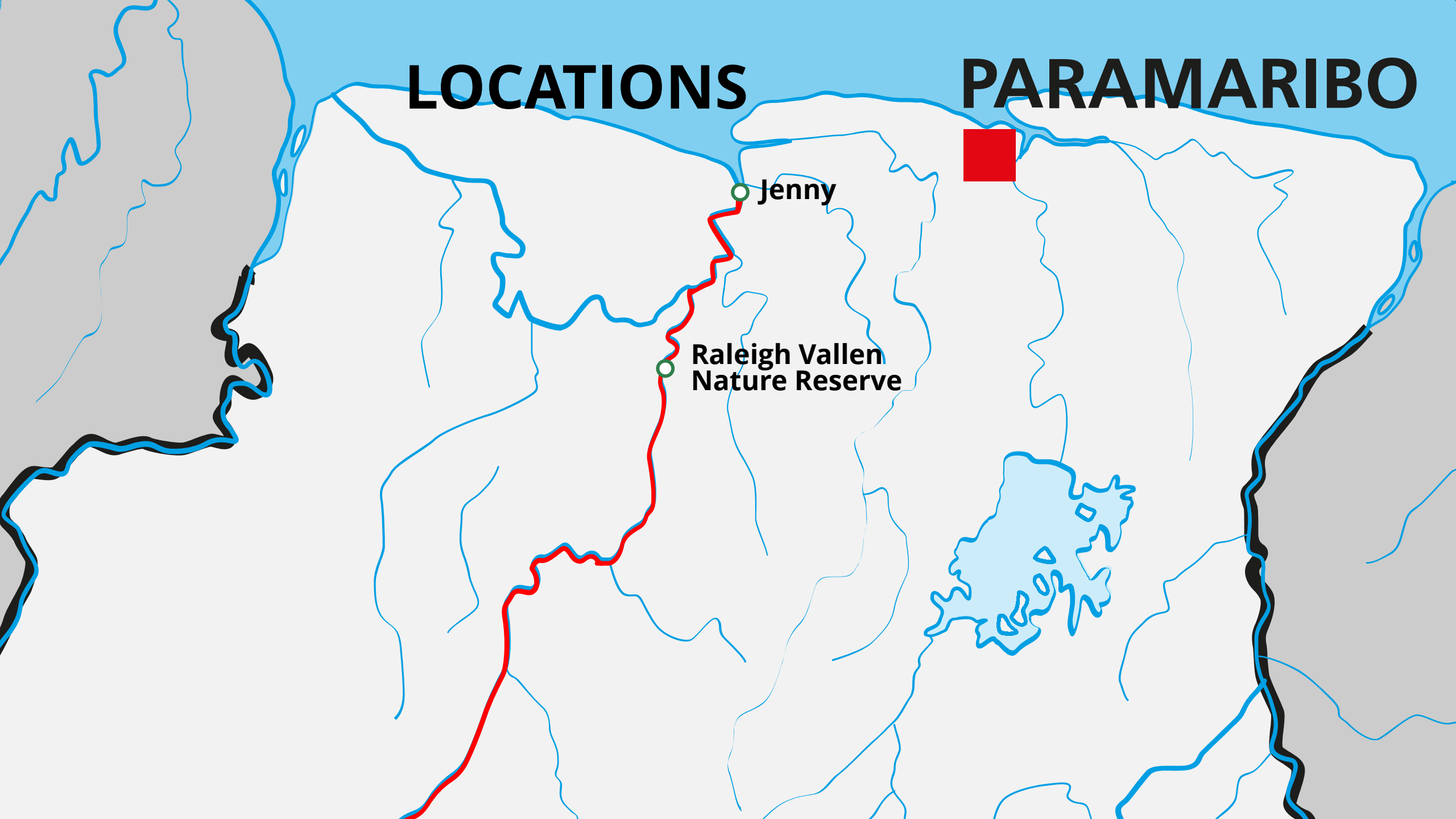
